- Verizon: Verizon service can come in and out. If you need to make a phone call, the Cedar Mountain Community Center, Rocky Hill
 Baptist Church and Deer Ridge Property Management have Verizon boosters that you can use from their parking lot.
- Sprint: Cedar Mountain Café has a Sprint booster. You can get service from inside the cafe, or the parking lot.
- AT&T/T-Mobile/Cricket/etc.: If you know someone in Connestee, you're lucky! You can get AT&T service from the lookout –
 otherwise you have to get into town. For all others, you pretty much have to go into town.
- WIFI: The Cedar Mountain Community Center has public wifi that can be accessed from their parking lot. The café has wifi that can
 be accessed from the dining room.
